ALL FUNDS GIVEN TO THE DIRECTOR, THE MAINTENANCE CONSTRUCTION MAN, OR OTHER STAFF MEMBERS OTHER THAN THE STAFF ADMINISTRATOR ARE MONITORED BY THE STAFF ADMINISTRATOR. YAHAIRA MEETS REGULARLY WITH THOSE STAFF MEMBERS AND GETS RECEIPTS FOR ALL MONEY SPENT AND ANY RETURNED MONEY THAT WAS OVER OR MAKES PAYMENT FOR ANY LACK BECAUSE PRICES WERE BIGGER THAN ESTIMATED. SINCE YAHAIRA IS IN CHARGE OF PAYROLL AND PAYING THE UTILITIES, THE INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR, APRIL HAVLIN, GIVES THE FUNDING FOR ALL ITEMS SHE WILL PAY DIRECTLY TO YAHAIRA. IN HONDURAS, THE NATIONAL DIRECTOR, MERCEDES, RECEIVES FUNDS DIRECTLY FROM THE INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR EITHER BY CASH IN HAND OR BY WIRE BANK TRANSFER. SHE THEN DISPERSES THE FUNDING BY PAYING OTHER STAFF MEMBERS, AND PURCHASING NEEDED SUPPLIES. SHE THEN MEETS WITH APRIL HAVLIN, THE INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR AND TURNS IN ALL RECEIPTS. YAHAIRA, THE STAFF

THE PROGRAM IN BOLIVIA IS MUCH SMALLER. THROUGH THE BAKERY THAT HOUSE
OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL HELPED THEM TO SET UP, THEY GENERATE A LOT OF THEIR
OWN

FUNDING. ALSO, THE CHURCH THAT THEY ARE UNDER THE UMBRELLA OF, PROVIDES A LOT OF DONATIONS IN KIND FOR THE WOMEN AND CHILDREN WHO LIVE IN A RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM AND SOME INGREDIENTS FOR THE BAKING PROGRAM. HOUSE OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL WORKS ALONGSIDE-THEM. FROM APRIL 2014 UNTIL JULY OF 2020 WHEN SHE PASSED AWAY, NELVY, THE NATIONAL DIRECTOR FOR BOLIVIA, MOSTLY HANDLED THE FUNDS DONATED TO HOUSE OF HOPE.
