ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF HEMP LEGACY FOUNDATION, INC. AN ARIZONA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. §10-11006, HEMP LEGACY FOUNDATION, INC., an Arizona nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation") presents the following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation.

- 1. The name of the corporation is changed to ARIZONA HYGIENE FOR HOPE.
- 2. The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were originally filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission on or about April 1, 2014, designated by File No. 19160396.
- 3. This amendment was duly adopted by act of the board of directors of the Corporation on February 5, 2019.
- 4. The Corporation has no members and action of such was not required for approval of this amendment.
- 5. Number 2 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended as follows:

PURPOSES AND POWERS AND INITIAL ACTIVITIES

- A. The Corporation is formed and organized and shall always be operated exclusively for charitable, research, and educational activities, solely and exclusively in the interest of the general public. More specifically, the objects, purposes and nature of the business of the Corporation is to honor veterans, encouraging and empowering individuals and motivating families to prosper by providing hygiene products and basic essentials; provided that the Corporations activities shall always be conducted only for purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) (the "Code").
- B. The Corporation's powers as aforesaid shall include, but shall not be limited to the several powers and purposes set forth in Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 10-3302, as amended or renumbered, or the analogous provision of any future Arizona nonprofit corporation code, which are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.
- C. The Corporation's initial activities will include to honor veterans, encouraging and empowering individuals and motivating families to prosper by providing hygiene products and basic essentials. The Corporation's activities

shall always be conducted only for purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
