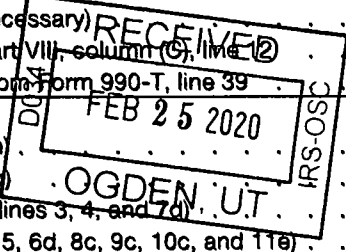

To broadcast 24/7/365 in the Florida Keys on WHNJ-FM (and world wide on the internet at WHNJ.org) the good news that Jesus is coming soon and it is time to get serious about our relationship with Him. To proclaim through various types of outreach (including a community health education van) that God who created us, sustains us, and loves us, is able to give us power in our daily lives to make good choices that will make a difference for now and eternity.

The Foundation leases antenna space on a commercial tower at 460 ft AGL, and operates under a FCC Class C3 permit, broadcasting ERP at 12.5 kw. We have the only full-power Christian FM radio station in the FL Keys, and offer music, religious, health, educational, and children's programming, through which we are proclaiming God as the answer for life's problems. We also co sponsor an annual week-end campmeeting where well-known radio speakers and musicians can meet together with local listeners for worship and seminars to learn how to prepare spiritually and physically for the soon coming of Jesus.
We are able to accomplish these goals with the financial help of 350-400 donors, many monthly, and others less frequently. About 4000 interested families receive our quarterly newsletter which includes a "Not By Accident" (but by God's design) nature segment in each newsletter.
The radio station is staffed by one full-time employee, plus one part-time contractor for programming.

The Foundation has a Ford 450 van outfitted as a community health and spiritual education van. The van is parked at pre-arranged and announced locations throughout the FL Keys, to serve the community with free blood-pressure testing, counseling, and spiritual helps. This van ministry is staffed by 2 full-time volunteers and about 20-30 part-time, well-trained, community volunteers who live near where the van is parked during the time it is open to the public.
We are able to provide these free community services due to the large donor base, most of whom also support the radio station.
