THE MARGARET PAXTON MEMORIAL TRUST OWNS A 17-ACRE PROPERTY IN LEESBURG, VA THAT SUPPORTS THE WORK OF OTHER NON-PROFITS SERVING CHILDREN IN NEED IN OUR COMMUNITY. THE PAXTON CAMPUS IS CURRENTLY HOME TO 'THE ARC OF LOUDOUN'. A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES DIRECT SERVICES TO MORE THAN 100 CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES THROUGH A K-12 SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOOL, AN INCLUSIVE PRESCHOOL. IN 2019 THE TRUST CONDUCTED 'WHAT'S YOUR WORD' WORKSHOPS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RYAN BARTEL FOUNDATION'S 'THE FORT' PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK TEENS AND SERVED 48 WE ALSO HAVE OUR COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM 'HOLIDAY HO-HO-HOPE' WHICH OPERATES IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 'MOBILE HOPE BUS' AND TAKES PLACE IN DECEMBER.
