- In 2019, ILOA was involved in the following activities.
 - Hosted a benefactor reception at SSTA in Singapore that offers the latest news regarding space and satellite technology.
 - Signed a Memorandum of Understanding with National Astronomical Observatories to co-sponsor the processing and publishing of Chang'e-3 LUT data in hopes of advancing astronomy from the moon.
 - ILOA conducted a series of 8 International Galaxy Forum events for teachers, students and the general public. Forums were held in the following locations:
 - Kona, HI, USA (March 29, 2019)
 - Busan, South Korea (April 13, 2019)
 - Silicon Valley, CA, USA (July 4, 2019)
 - Hilo, HI, USA (August 17, 2019)
 - Hutchinson, KS, USA (August 24, 2019)
 - Vancouver, BC, Canada (September 7, 2019)
 - Scarsdale, NY, USA (October 11, 2019)
 - Kamuela, HI, USA (October 30, 2019)

The purpose of the forums is to advance general science education throughout the world. These events support school teachers, students and the general public by advancing 21st-Century galaxy education. Materials for the Galaxy Forums were produced and distributed to educators including educational Galaxy Posters that display statistics and information about the Galaxy. Presentations topics included:

- Recent highlights and future prospects of the Subaru Telescope
- A Review on Astronomy, Space Science, and Technology Development in Thailand
- Radio Astronomy On and Around the Moon
- Astronomy from the Moon
- Applying Hawaii Astrophysics Leadership to 21st Century Frontiers

- In 2017, ILOA announced that in collaboration with Moon Express, they will build the first International Lunar Observatory on the South Pole of the Moon in 2019.
- In 2017, ILOA continued scientific research and development on its planned Moon Missions with Moon Express (of Florida), and development of its scientific payload for astronomical observation and communications with Canadensys (of Toronto, Canada).
- In 2015, ILOA worked on advancing a grant to build a Research and Education Center in Kamuela, HI. Once constructed, the Center will be an important education and science resource for the community.
- In 2012, ILOA conducted scientific research on their proposed instrument for a lunar mission with Intek (of Canada) and Moon Express (of California). As a result of these studies, in May of 2013, ILOA unveiled flight test hardware for the first private telescope that will be launched to the Moon. Moon Express will be sending a series of robotic missions to the Moon which will carry a shoebox-sized telescope to test the ILOA's software and hardware on the moon. The telescope is scheduled to be launched by 2018.
- ILOA began participation in a Human Lunar Lander Study with Golden Spike Company in December 2012. This study is still under way.
