ADDITIONALLY, MU ALPHA THETA PROVIDES FREE GRAPHING CALCULATORS, ASSORTED MERCHANDISE, AND MATH-RELATED DVDS AS PRIZES TO ITS CHAPTERS.

THE ORGANIZATION SUPPORTED THE ACTIVITIES OF 12 OF ITS CHAPTERS WITH CHAPTER GRANTS UP TO \$1,000 EACH AND 17 OF ITS CHAPTERS WITH COMPETITION GRANTS UP TO \$500 EACH.

NATIONAL CONVENTION. THE ROCKET CITY MATH LEAGUE WAS OPEN TO ALL MIDDLE—SCHOOL THROUGH TWO-YEAR COLLEGE STUDENTS. PRIZES INCLUDED CERTIFICATES, TROPHIES, PLAQUES, MATHEMATICAL GAMES, AND PUZZLES. IN MU ALPHA THETA'S FREE MATHEMATICAL MINUTES CONTEST, STUDENTS MADE FUN, EDUCATIONAL, SHORT VIDEOS TO TEACH MATH LESSONS TO OTHER STUDENTS. VIDEOS WERE SCORED ON THEIR ORIGINALITY, ACCURACY, AND "WOW" FACTOR. WINNERS' VIDEOS WERE POSTED ONLINE AND THEIR CHAPTERS WERE GIVEN CASH AWARDS.
