DLR Trust had three family groups that served as Trustees and managed the private foundation created by their parents, Adolph and Bettiruth Susholtz. Devon Susholtz and Stephen Purvis, one of the family groups, desired to split off one third of the private foundations assets to their own Donor Advised Fund.

Devon Susholtz and Stephen Purvis resigned as Trustees of the DLR Trust and waived all rights and claims against the Trust. On May 28, 2019 cash representing their one third of the fair market value of the DLR Trust net assets was distributed to the Fidelity Charitable - DSD Fund as designated by Devon Susholtz and Stephen Purvis. This distribution of assets represents a substantial contraction as the total of the distribution is greater than 25% of the fair market value of the net assets of DLR Trust as of January 1, 2019.
