Deadlines for submission of completed applications are the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month prior to the meeting. Applications submitted after the stated deadline will not be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications more than 4 pages plus requested documentation will not be considered. Please do not send any documentation that is not specifically requested. Notification of awards will be made by mail within 30 days of the respective Board meeting.
