The authorized loan amount was previously increased to \$25,700,000 in total pursuant to the First Amendment to the agreement in November of 2015, the Second Amendment to the agreement in September of 2017, the Third Amendment to the agreement in December of 2017, and the Fourth Amendment to the agreement in December of 2018. In December of 2019, the Fifth Amendment to the agreement in becember of 2013. In becember of 2017, the Fifth Amendment to the agreement was executed increasing the total authorized PRI loan amount to \$29,100,000. During 2019, Building Hope received additional funding via additional PRI loans of \$2,500,000 in November and \$3,000,000 in December. As of December 31, 2019, the Foundation has loaned \$28,700,000 of the \$29,100,000 authorized. The purpose of the PRI loans is to provide facilities financing to Idaho charter schools. The lending arrangement between the Foundation and Building Hope qualified as a Program Related Investment.
