Healthcare unit cost inflation is driven by compliance with ever-expanding regulatory requirements, shortages of highly skilled labor and evolving medical and information technology. The health care market basket is unrelated to that of the average individual consumer. The board-approved executive compensation philosophy specifies that salary ranges will be established for hospital CEOs and executives, with midpoints aligned with the 50th percentile of comparable system ho spital data, and having a 50 percent spread from minimum to maximum. A hospital CEO has a maximum potential incentive of 30 or 35 percent of base salary based upon size and scope of hospital. (Incentive potential is industry norm) Other hospital executives have a maximum motential incentive of 25 to 30 percent of base salary.
