The settlement agreement created and funded the National Center for Addiction Studies and Treatment Foundation whose mission is to support the activities of the Center for Wellness and Recovery at the Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences. The settlement agreement provided two initial sources of revenue for the Foundation: 1) Purdue Pharma to provide \$102,500,000 and 2) the Sackler family to provide \$75,000,000 in chartiable contributions over a five-year period beginning in 2020 and concluding in 2025. Those contributions is to be paid in increments of \$15,000,000 each year.
