GRANTS WILL BE AWARDED TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS WITH 501(C)(3) STATUS FOR SPECIFIC PROGRAMS WITH A CLEAR EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AT PAROCHIAL, PRIVATE, OR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS WHO ATTEND ACCREDITED UNDER-GRADUATE INSTITUTES OR ACADEMIC OR TRAINING CAMPS IN A NON-TRADITIONAL SPORT AND HAVE A MINIMUM 2.75 GPA.
