Per Revenue Ruling 78-387, the excess distribution carryover from Part XIII, Line 9 is transferred to the transferee foundations. The Annie Gray Sprunt Charitable Trust has an excess distribution carryover to 2020 of \$37,042. This was split evenly between the AGS Charitable Trust u/a/d May 21, 1965 and the DHS Charitable Trust u/a/d May 21, 1965.
