In this regard, Footnote 27 on page 23 expressly states as follows: "This principle [a substantial majority of the Board should be independent] does not apply to private foundations; medical research institutions...; supporting organizations or subsidiaries that are required by law...to include representatives of the supported organizations or sponsoring charities on their board..." [footnote listing continues with several other specific types of Section 501(c)(3) organizations].
