Pacific Whale Foundation's mission is to protect the ocean through science and advocacy and to inspire environmental stewardship. Our vision is to be the people's environmental organization for the protection of the world's whales, dolphins and other marine animals living wild in their natural habitat. We believe that it is essential to involve the public in our mission. We encourage you to become a part of our global community of people who care about the future of our oceans and marine wildlife.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - First Accomplishment

Our Research program uses a two-pronged approach of long-term and shortterm projects to contribute to the scientific understanding of marine life
and marine ecosystems. Shared through peer reviewed scientific journals,
reports and worldwide meetings of the scientific community and resourcemanagement agencies, our studies have looked at the impacts of human
pressures, such as marine debris and vessel traffic and tourism on humpback
whales in the North and South Pacific and dolphins within the Maui Nui
region. Our efforts are focused primarily in Hawaii, Australia and Ecuador,
with additional collaborations throughout the Pacific.

In 2019, our research team managed 10 research projects concurrently and carried out collaborative research with 14 different organizations to further our understanding of whales and dolphins across Hawaii, Alaska, Australia, Chile and Ecuador. We presented at marine mammal and whale

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conferences in Spain, Australia and the U.S., and published 3 peer-reviewed journal articles, and presented 2 technical reports at scientific working groups: 1. Incidence of odontocetes with dorsal fin collapse in Maui Nui, Hawaii 2. Sightings of an adult male killer whale match humpback whale breeding seasons in both hemispheres in the Eastern Tropical Pacific 3. Distribution patterns of east Australia humpback whales in Hervey Bay, Queensland: a historical perspective 4. Strandings and mortality of cetaceans due to interactions with fishing nets in Ecuador 5. Preliminary report on the impacts of swim-with-whale tourism on humpback whale behavior in Hervey Bay, Queensland, Australia.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4b - Second Accomplishment

Understanding that it is essential to develop a generation of leaders who know and care for the marine environment, our Education program creates and provides science-based opportunities that engage the public in conservation and advocacy. Through our Keiki Whalewatch program, Ocean Camp, Tide Pool Explorations, Plastic Pollution Solutions, hands-on marine exploratory science labs, internships, public Information Stations, community events and more, millions of individuals from all walks of life have accessed quality opportunities to learn about protecting the ocean through science and advocacy. In 2019, we served 3,253 participants in standards-based Keiki (kid) Whalewatch programs; 1,050 Ocean Campers with hands-on science programming; and 1,210 middle and high school students through the Plastic Pollution Solutions program.

Kids Whalewatch Program: Our customized ecotours through our keiki whalewatch program offers a free and highly subsidized opportunity for

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schoolchildren in Maui County to learn about whales living wild in their natural habitat. We also offer an optional classroom program with standards-based, grade-level appropriate, hands-on activities for students. The program is open to school groups from pre-K to high school. For many participants, this is their first time seeing humpback whales from a boat and will solidify a life-long love of and desire to protect these animals. In 2019, 3,253 total students participated in Keiki Whalewatch and financial assistance was provided for 497 students and parents.

Ocean Camp: Ocean Camp features hands-on science activities and daily field trips for children in grades 1-5, led by scientists and educators. With the goal of introducing young people to the marine environment through engaging activities and field experiences that inspire them to care about and protect the ocean, campers learn about Maui's natural environment while building new skills and making new friends. Each week centers around an ocean-related theme, and each day includes a nature-based field trip. 2019 sites included the Atlantis Submarine; Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale National Marine Sanctuary Visitor Center & Fishpond; Kapalua Coastal Trail; La Perouse Bay; Maui Canoe Club; Maui Ocean Center; Waikamoi Preserve Hike and more. 2019 enjoyed participation by 1,050 campers, 16 of which whom received financial assistance through our Keiki scholarship program.

Plastic Pollution Solutions: Launched in the Fall of 2018 through the assistance of the County of Maui Environmental Protection & Sustainability Division, our Plastic Pollution Solutions program offers classroom collaborations to exchange educator learning techniques, expertise and resources that further develop Maui Nui intermediate and high school

students into future stewards of our planet's oceans. The program includes a screening of the 22-minute film, A Plastic Ocean, as well as curriculum and activities appropriate for varying subject areas to familiarize youth with a real-world environmental problem and to introduce them to real-world solutions. In 2019, 1,210 students benefited from this free program.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4c - Third Accomplishment
Our Conservation program collaborates with local and international
organizations to address environmental threats in ways that can be
inclusive of and accessible to the community. Aligned with our research and
education priorities, efforts promote a solution-based approach to critical
issues, such as endangered species awareness, collecting and monitoring
marine debris, keeping our oceans clean and safe, reducing our carbon
footprint and more. Recent initiatives include RETHINK single-use plastics,
The Last Straw, Be Whale Aware & Dolphin Wise, the Coastal Marine Debris
Monitoring Program, and Volunteers on Vacation.

In 2019, the conservation department launched the RETHINK campaign, aimed at educating the public about the detriment of single-use plastics on the marine environment and offering alternatives that are accessible to all. The campaign's goal is to inspire consumers to refuse buying disposable products, reduce our overall consumption, and reuse materials we already have. We encourage people to eliminate their single-use plastic waste by rethinking their everyday decisions surrounding modern-day conveniences. The RETHINK campaign has reached thousands of people worldwide through our social media platforms, encouraged hundreds of people to pledge to reduce their use of single-use plastics and Pacific Whale Foundation has worked to

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eliminate single-use plastics in our own operations. With plastic pollution entering our oceans at a rate of 8 million tons per year, increasing education about this topic is pertinent to the health of our oceans and planet as a whole. Pacific Whale Foundation's research has shown plastics to be the dominant debris category for debris items in Maui County and a significant risk to marine life.

Coastal Marine Debris Monitoring Program: A supplement to our systematic surveys, the Coastal Marine Debris Monitoring Program allows members of the public to become citizen scientists by cleaning up a beach of their choice and recording data on what objects they find. Through this program, we are not only able to engage with the community, but to also gain a better understanding of where exactly debris is coming from in order to help identify solutions for the plastic pollution problem. In 2019, we partnered with 366 citizen scientists and removed 28,893 pieces of debris. More than 73% of trash collected was plastic, with the top three items collected being plastic pieces, cigarette butts, and bottle caps. In 2018, PWF published the first study to determine trends of large marine debris items floating within Maui County waters. A total of 260 survey days were completed between 2013 to 2017, collecting 2,095 items of debris from the ocean, of which 90% were plastic. This data is used to help develop mitigation measures and to teach others to "RETHINK" single-use plastics in their daily lives.

Last Straw Campaign: Straws are one of the most common marine debris items in the world, and along with other single-use plastics, are polluting our oceans. 500 million straws a day are used in the United States alone,

enough straws to wrap around the early 2.5 times every day. Straws are hard to recycle and transport to landfills because of their size and weight, they often end up in our oceans. Since 2015, we have kept 500,000 straws out of our local landfills, partnered with 25 restaurants to stop using plastic straws and partnered with over 4,000 individuals to start using reusable straws.
