Monthly Food Pantry and Food Distribution program during SAUSD school breaks provides monthly emergency food pantry services to hungry Santa Ana families consisting of dry food such as rice, pasta, beans, canned soups, canned mixed vegetables and corn, peanut butter, jelly, tuna fish and cereal. The Food Distribution programs take place during SAUSD school breaks - winter, spring and summer and provides dry food and cooking needs such as cooking oil as well as fresh food such as garlic, onions, tomatoes and fruits such as apples, oranges, strawberries and bananas.
