

LECTION OF AN INDEPENDENT AUDIT FIRM. THE MEMBERS OF THIS COMMITTEE, ALL OF WHOM HAVE FINA NCIAL BACKGROUNDS, CONSIST OF THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD, CHAIR OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE TREASURER. THE AUDIT COMMITTEE MEETS INDEPENDENTLY WITH THE CPA FIRM PRIOR TO THE AUDIT BEING PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THIS PROCESS HAS NOT CHANGED SINCE THE PRIOR YEAR.
