Socioeconomic factors also play a role in the health of the population that Barrett Hospital & HealthCare services. Beaverhead County has a higher percentage of the population that falls below the federal poverty levels and higher uninsured rates than National and State of Montana measures. 16.1% of the population of Beaverhead County is considered low income and falls below the federal poverty levels compared to 14.4% for the State of Montana. The members of the board are publicly elected residents of Beaverhead County. In addition, Barrett Hospital has a large volunteer program. Approximately 64 volunteers contribute their time and efforts to the hospital. The hospital also relies on community members for various advisory councils including the Patient Advisory Council. Barrett Hospital & HealthCare is the only hospital in Beaverhead County. Medical staff privileges in the hospital are open to all qualified physicians and providers. Barrett Hospital operates an emergency room that is accessible to anyone needing care regardless of their ability to pay. The emergency room has approximately 4,000 visits annually. Additionally. Barrett Hospital and HealthCare operates a walk-in clinic 5 days per week.
