The Boss Foundation encourages use of the Minnesota Common Grant Application Form developed by the Minnesota Council on Foundations. Organizations not in Minnesota may also use this form. The form and other useful information is <u>available online at the Minnesota Council on Foundations' website, www mcf.org</u> If you use the Common Grant Application Form, be sure to include the information listed below. If you do not use the Common Grant Application Form, your proposal must be in the form set forth below:

PHYSICAL COMPOSITION OF PROPOSAL:

The Proposal shall consist of five pages

- Page 1: A <u>one-page</u> letter addressed to the President from your President or other person authorized by your organization to solicit contributions. In this letter, state:
 - (a) The dollar amount of your request.
 - (b) The purpose for which the funds will be used; and
 - (c) Any special time constraints on the receipt of the contribution; i.e , fiscal year end, capital or operating support campaign ending on a specific date, etc
- Page 2: Evidence from the IRS of your current 501(c)(3) status.
- Page 3-5: Any supporting documentation you wish to include.

Proposals may be submitted at any time, however, the Board of Directors customarily meets in June of each year to decide on distributions for the year.
