Impact of COVID-19

In March 2020, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) as a pandemic, which continues to spread throughout the United States. While the disruption is currently expected to be temporary, there is uncertainty around the duration. NJII received a PPP loan in May 2020 to offset some of the potential negative impacts of COVID-19 on its business. The construction and opening of NJII's Cell and Gene Therapy center was delayed due to the impact of COVID-19 which negatively impacted current year results. While NJII expects this matter to negatively impact its financial position for 2021, the related financial impact cannot be reasonably estimated at this time.
