Grants are geographically limited to organizations within the United States, though strong preference will be given to organizations serving the needs of southwestern Pennsylvania. Support generally will not be granted to fraternal organizations; conferences or seminar attendance; specialized health campaigns; or national organizations. No support will be granted for private foundations as defined under Internal Revenue Code Section 509(a); loans or direct grants to individuals; or political campaigns, parties, or candidates.

Selection is based on a scoring system, which considers community service, class standing, and financial need. It is renewable up to a maximum of four years and the student must retain full-time status and a passing grade point average. Verification must be sent annually.
