RESTATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WILLIAM PEACE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is William Peace University Foundation. The principal office of the corporation is 15 East Peace Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27604 (Wake County).

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To promote the continued operation of William Peace University for the purposes which have characterized its operation during the years since the university was organized, and to that end, to assist in developing and increasing the facilities of William Peace University, for broader educational opportunities for and service to its students and alumni and other persons and organizations sharing in the program of William Peace University, by encouraging gifts for permanent improvements or operating expenses, and by such other proper means as may seem advisable, and to aid, foster and promote the growth, progress and general welfare of William Peace University, and, in particular, to provide funds for the financial support of said university.

- (b) To receive, hold and administer any gifts made with the object of serving purposes other than those for which the organizations, institutions and individuals supporting William Peace University ordinarily make sufficient appropriations and contributions.
- (c) To act without profit as trustee of educational and charitable trusts; to administer gifts, grants or loans of money or property, real or personal, whether made by or for the benefit of public governmental bodies, state or national, or religious or charitable institutions or organizations, or by or for the benefit of corporations or natural persons, and whether in the form of conventional express trusts or otherwise.
- (d) To raise funds and solicit gifts and conduct campaigns for financial support of William Peace University by whatever organization or institution the university may be operated, and to promote by all proper means the continued existence and operation of the university as an educational institution in the State of North Carolina.
- (e) To do any and all things necessary, suitable, convenient and proper in connection with or incident to the accomplishment of any purpose specified in this Article III, and in general, to do any and all things and exercise any and all powers in furtherance of any one or more purposes specified herein which may be lawful and proper under the laws of North Carolina. The foundation is not organized for pecuniary profit and shall have no power to make or declare dividends. No part of its net earning shall inure to the benefit of any person but shall be devoted exclusively to the promotion of the purposes specified in this Article.

- (f) Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the purposes of the corporation shall be limited to those purposes described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (g) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- (h) Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERS

As of June 10, 2019, the corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors and said Board shall have full power to adopt, amend and promulgate the by-laws of this corporation and to amend the Articles of Incorporation. The qualifications of the Directors, the different classes of Directors, if any, and the manner in which directors shall be elected shall be set forth in the by-laws. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than 4 members. The by-laws may provide that said members may be elected for a term from 1 to 3

years and the Board may be divided into classes of Directors holding varying terms of office in order that only one or more Directors shall be elected at one time. It is the purpose and intent of this corporation to be a charitable and eleemosynary institution within the meaning of the revenue laws of this state and nation, and the Directors shall manage its affairs in conformity with such laws to the end that it qualify at all times under such laws as a charitable and eleemosynary institution for the purpose of supporting church related educational institutions.

ARTICLE VI

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation was the office of the First Presbyterian Church, 112 S. Salisbury Street, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina; and the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address was Dr. Albert G. Edwards.

The street and mailing address, and county of the current registered office of the corporation is: 15 Peace Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27604 (Wake County). The name of the current registered agent at such address is Brian C. Ralph. The address of the registered office and the registered agent is identical.

ARTICLE VII

ARTICLE VIII

In addition to the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of North Carolina, the corporation shall have full power and authority to administer any gifts and contributions to the corporation in accordance with the conditions attached to said gifts and contributions by the donors thereof.

ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
