OF

SOUTHEAST FOUNDATION, INC.

NOW KNOWN AS:

AHS OF GREATER MEMPHIS FOUNDATION, INC.

Pursuant to the unanimous approval of the Directors of Southeast Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation"), at a meeting of the Board of Directors duly convened on December 31, 2019, and in compliance with the First Amended Charter, filed with the Secretary of State of Tennessee on March 28, 1990, and filed of record in the Register's Office of Shelby County, Tennessee on April 19, 1990, and further in compliance with the Bylaws and T.C.A. Sections 48-60-101, et seq., of the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, the following Second Amended and Restated Charter of the Corporation is adopted:

- 1. The name of Southeast Foundation, Inc. effective with the filing of this Second Amended and Restated Charter is amended and changed to AHS of Greater Memphis Foundation, Inc.
 - 2. (A) The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.
 - (B) The fiscal year end of the Corporation is June 30.
 - 3. (A) The address and principal office of the Corporation in the State of Tennessee shall be: AHS of Greater Memphis Foundation, Inc., c/o Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., 2220 Union Avenue, Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee 38104.
 - (B) The registered agent of the Corporation shall be: J Martin Regan, Jr., One Commerce Square, Suite 2900, 40 South Main Street, Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee 38103.
 - (C) The Secretary of State Control Number is: 0163339.
 - 4 The Corporation is non-sectarian.
- 5. The Corporation shall have no members; it shall be governed by its Board of Directors. The Corporation shall not have, nor issue shares, and shall pay no dividends. However, the Corporation may pay reasonable compensation for other services rendered on behalf of the Corporation and reimbursement of reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the Corporation.

6. A. The Corporation is a public benefit corporation and is not for profit. The Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to, and operated exclusively for nonprofit purposes, and no part of the income or assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to or inure to the benefit of any individual, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the charitable purposes set forth herein.

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- B. No substantial part of the activities of the nonprofit corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the nonprofit corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements for) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition of, any candidate for public office, and there is an absolute prohibition against any political activity
- 7. The Corporation shall be organized and operated as a Tennessee nonprofit corporation and shall be a Supporting Organization to Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., a Tennessee nonprofit corporation having Tennessee Secretary of State Control Number 84095. The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Code. The Corporation is organized to operate exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the function of and to carry out the purposes of Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., including but not limited to, the purposes of.
 - (A) To provide comprehensive behavioral healthcare services to the greater Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee community; and
 - (B) To provide outpatient and intensive outpatient care, home-based and community-based programs, including a continuum of crisis services to the residents of the greater Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee community, and its surrounding areas, and
 - (C) To provide alcohol and drug therapy, individual and group therapy, crisis services; and
 - (D) To provide a broad array of mental health care services as the organization promotes and supports and provides services for the overall holistic wellness in our community.
- 8. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law
- 9. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the Corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding sections of any future Internal Revenue Code, and a preference shall be given to Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., and to recommendations made by this supported

organization, provided each recipient must be qualified as exempt under Internal Revenue Service Code Section 501(c)(3) as an active public charity. Further, the Corporation's property shall not be conveyed to any organization created or operated for profit or to any individual for less than fair market value of such property, and all assets remaining after the payment of the Corporation's debts shall be conveyed or distributed only to an organization or organizations created and operated for nonprofit purposes similar to those of the Corporation

- 10. The powers of the Corporation are:
 - (A) To accept, hold, invest, reinvest, manage and administer any gifts, assets, bequests, devises, benefits of trust and property of any sort, without limitation as to amount or value, and to use, disburse or donate the income or principal thereof for exclusively charitable purposes in connection with promoting and advancing the charitable activities of the Corporation;

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- (B) To buy, own, sell, convey, assign, mortgage or lease any interest in real estate and personal property and to construct, maintain and operate improvements thereon as may be necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of its purposes;
- (C) To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness of all types, including bonds, in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or other lien on the Corporation's property;
- (D) To exercise fiduciary powers to the fullest extent permissible by law and to enter into any authorized trust agreements and give bond for the performance of such fiduciary relationships and to consult with, retain and otherwise deal with professional advisors, banks, trust companies or investment advisors in all matters determined by the Board of Directors to be in the best interests of the Corporation, so long as such activity is in compliance with the provisions of this Charter, and as may be permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code.
- (E) To do and perform all acts reasonably necessary for or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes of the Corporation, and to do any and all things and exercise any and all powers, rights, privileges which a corporation may now or hereafter be authorized to do or exercise under the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-58-101, et seq., or the corresponding provision of any future Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, and as may be permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt as a public charity from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986,

as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code.

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- 11. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of not less than five (5) Directors, all of whom shall be appointed by the Executive Committee of the Board of Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., unless otherwise specified by the Board of Directors of Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc.
- 12. The Corporate Bylaws of this Foundation shall require that it report its activity through Minutes to the Board of the supported organization, Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc and that it maintain compliance with IRS requirements to continuously serve as a Supporting Organization to Alliance Healthcare Services, Inc., or its successor.
- 13. No Director shall have the right to exercise veto power over the actions of the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- 14. The Corporation shall fully indemnify and hold harmless its Directors and Officers as permissible under the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, and any amendments thereto.
- 15. The governance documents of this Corporation shall at all times comply with the requirements of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3); and, such documents shall be reviewed and amended from time to time as may be necessary or appropriate to fully comply with mandates of the Code. In furtherance of such compliance, the Corporation shall adopt and follow a conflict of interest policy and disclosure confirmation, and if applicable, adopt an employee protection whistleblower policy, and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws.
- 16. The Charter may be amended at any regular or specially called meeting of the Board of Directors by a majority of those Directors in attendance in person or electronically or by proxy, provided a quorum is present. There shall be no requirement for the approval by any third person(s) under Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-60-301, or the corresponding provision of any supplement thereto.
- 17. This Second Amended and Restated Charter has been approved unanimously by the Board of Directors of the Corporation at a regular meeting duly convened in accordance with its Charter, the corporate Bylaws and the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, where a quorum was present on February 20, 2020, there being no requirement for approval by any third party.

18. This Second Amended and Restate Charter shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Tennessee Secretary of State. Thereafter, this document shall be filed of record in the Register's Office of Shelby County, Tennessee, and retained in the Corporate Minute Book.
