This year the Γriends organization provided funding to replace the aging roof and flooring of the CJC facility in Provo (\$85,280.00). Additionally, the Friends organization provided remaining needed funding to co locate CJC services in a facility in Juab County to serve children/families within their local community, rather than having these families and professionals travel significant distance to the Provo location. As planned, the Juab County community is now supporting and providing the CJC program within their local area. An extensive effort is now underway to provide CJC services in an additional new CJC facility to be located in American Fork City to better serve child abuse victims residing in northern Utah County cities and rural area. 4c: Additionally, the Friends organization provided direct funding to the CJC Program, which functions under Utah County Government. This support includes training for MDT professionals, medical services, and essential victim support services for children and families. Part III, 4d Public awareness and educational information regarding child abuse issues in our community and the services that are provided to serve child victims/witnesses through the Utah County Children's Justice Center Program are prepared and presented as part of our charitable mission and purpose. A major goal of our annual Hope & Healing Festival is public awareness regarding this critical community issue (shared expense of \$36). This year we utilized social media and multiple donated avenues to encourage our community members to

become part of the solution by preventing child abuse and reporting abuse in behalf of the children of our community.
