The Foundation made such irrevocable distributions in the current year and prior years to donor advised funds sponsored by the National Christian Foundation Tampa Bay, Inc., and Impact Investing Charitable Foundation, Inc., ("the Sponsoring Organizations"), whose purposes are consistent with those of the Foundation, for the purpose of providing grants to organizations that have been recognized by the IRS as public charities under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and whose exempt purposes are consistent with and in furtherance of those of the Foundation and the Sponsoring Organizations. The Sponsoring Organizations vet proposed grantees that meet these criteria, as well as other specific criteria of the Sponsoring Organizations. The Foundation serves as the advisor to advise the Sponsoring Organizations of the Foundation's wishes concerning distributions from the donor advised funds, but understands that the Sponsoring Organizations will evaluate whether the advice is consistent with the specific needs of the proposed recipient and deserving of the support according to the criteria of the Sponsoring Organizations.

The Foundation holds donor advised funds for two purposes. The first is to preserve anonymity or to facilitate single or multiyear grants. Such grants are normally distributed to selected grantees within twelve months of the Foundation's distribution to the donor advised fund. The second type of donor advised fund is an evergreen charitable investment vehicle, whereby the Foundation maintains a pool of funds intended to be used for

program related investments and/or mission related investments permissible under the sponsoring charity's policies and procedures.

Please note that Terry Templeton and Cathryn Harper were both employed by Templeton Capital Management, LLC ("TCM") through December 31, 2019, which provided administrative, management, and other services to the Foundation for a fee. The amount paid to TCM and noted in Part VIII, Line 3 reflect \$71,814 in compensation ultimately paid to Terry Templeton, and \$25,086 paid to Cathryn Harper through TCM. TCM is a single member limited liability company and disregarded entity for federal income tax purposes, whose sole member was The Wilfred S. Templeton Revocable Trust. Since more than 65% of the beneficial interest of the Trust resides with the Foundation, TCM is not a disqualified person with respect to the Foundation (see IRC Sec. 4946(a)(1)(G)). In addition, the payments made by TCM to Terry Templeton and Cathryn Harper are not indirect acts of self-dealing because they meet the exception to self-dealing for the payment of reasonable compensation for the performance of personal services which are reasonable and necessary to carry out the exempt purposes of the Foundation under Reg. Sec. 53.4941(d)-3(c)(1).

During the year ended August 31, 2020 the Foundation became the sole member of TCM through a contribution of the interest from The Wilfred S. Templeton Revocable Trust. Further, beginning January 1, 2020 both Terry Templeton and Cathryn Harper began serving as employees of the Foundation directly. Therefore, the Foundation does not expect to report payments to TCM in future tax years.
