obtain college scholarships through their participation in the sport of basketball. On August 6-8, 2020, the MBG hosted its
annual program service event in furtherance of that purpose, the Midwest Basketball Showcase. The Midwest Basketball
Showcase was created to allow youth basketball players (under the age of 18) to demonstrate their skills in front of college
coaches so that these college coaches can identify young basketball players who may be skilled enough to be offered a college
scholarship. The monies generated by the Midwest Basketball Group is also utitilized to defray some of the educational
expenses incurred by the law students that the MBG supports. In August of 2020, approximately 1,100 youth participated
in the program service event operated by the MBG.
