Lastly, an Associate member can hold the membership through a church, FFA chapter, an association or by a corporation not producing agricultural products. A Voting member can be a family that gets the majority of its gross income from the sale of average agricultural products. A voting member can also be held by a retired agricultural person living on an income or social security accrued and not employed full time in another occupation. A Voting member can also be held by a partnership or corporation receiving the majority of income from the sale of agricultural products
