

- Connecting immigrants and long-time Americans: CANMP connects immigrants helpful people and resources in the community through Family Mentor Teams that work with particular immigrant families. In FY 2020 we had 20 FMTs with roughly 120 participants and volunteers.

- Meeting immigrant needs: CANMP meets immigrant needs for housing, language, transportation, employment, and basic essentials through partnerships with local institutions and programs.

- Educating the broader community: CANMP's staff and volunteers offer programs and give presentations to community groups, schools, and other audiences to educate people about the challenges that immigrants face and the benefits they bring to our area.

These three program services, along with the three major programs listed in Part III above, constitute roughly 80% of our ExecutiveDirector's time and 100% of our staff time and our independent contractors' time.\$ 17,033 (80% of ED salary) + \$ 7,530 (year-round staff) + \$ 6,393 (summer staff) + \$ 5,274 (80% of taxes) + \$ 1,000 (contractor) = \$ 37,230
