FULL-TIME TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND THE PLAYSCHOOL SUPERVISOR WAS

PROMOTED TO PLAYSCHOOL DIRECTOR.

WE HAD UNCERTAINTY WHEN THE PANDEMIC HIT AND WE HAD TO SHUT DOWN THE PLAYSCHOOL FOR 2.5 MONTHS STARTING IN MID-MARCH. FORTUNATELY, WE WERE ABLE TO RECEIVE SOME FEDERAL ASSISTANCE TO REOPEN IN JUNE. WE WERE ABLE TO HIRE TWO MORE EMPLOYEES FOR THE PLAYSCHOOL AND MANAGE THE HIGH TURNOVER, AS PARENTS PULLED THEIR CHILDREN OUT OF THE PROGRAM DUE TO FEARS ABOUT THE PANDEMIC.

OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR WAS SELECTED AS A PRESENTER AND MENTOR FOR THE NATURE AND PLACE-BASED EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATORS SUMMER INSTITUTE WHICH WAS VIRTUAL THIS YEAR. IN JULY, OUR ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO EQUITY IN A PUBLIC STATEMENT AND HAVE TAKEN STEPS TO INCREASE AWARENESS AND ANTI-RACISM IN OUR STAFF AND PROGRAMS.
