Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require the management of the Company to evaluate tax positions taken by the Company. Management has evaluated the Company's tax positions and concluded that the Company has maintained its tax exempt status and had taken no uncertain tax positions that require recognition or disclosure in the financial statements. Therefore, no provision or liability for income taxes has seen included in the financial statements.
