Part I, line 13 - AVC Foundation was a supporting 501(c)3 to AFVW Inc. which was a non-profit Continuing Care Retirement Community
(CCRC). In 2019, AFVW Inc. filed for bankruptcy and left AVC Foundation having to reorganize as a public charity, which was accomplished
in 2019. In the process, AFVW Inc. had two encumbered funds that were transferred to AVC Foundation. The bankruptcy also created a fund
for the support of residents who had their CCRC contracts voided. The California Attorney General's Office directed that this fund be
deposited with Inland Empire Community Foundation until proper procedures for handling thie fund could be developed. The two
encumbered funds from AFVW Inc. were also transferred to IECF since their purpose was inconsistent with AVCF's Articles of Incorporation
and By-laws, but were consistent with those of IECF. The funds transferred to IECF are what is listed in Part I line 13.
