Baumgartner Knights of Columbus Council No. 5452 in conjunction with Knights of Columbus Councils across the State of Michigan conduct fund raising (the MI or Toostie Roll Drives) to raise funds to assist mentally impaired persons. The expenses of this fund raiser are the cost of the Tootsie Rolls, permits, and supplies. In 2020, the fall drive raised a gross amount of \$6,266 \$ 6,266 was donated to organizations that assist the mentally impaired. (The 2020 spring drive was not conducted due to Covid-19.) \$710 in expenses were covered by the council so the gross proceeds of the event were donated to charities. Gross Income for Other fund raising activities by the Fr. Baumgartner Knights of Columbus Council No. 5452 included the following: (included on Schedule G \$8,562.) Lenten Fish Fries Spaghetti Dinners (included on Schedule G \$6,003) Line 8: Other Revenue K of C State Raffle and Vocations Support rebates \$631, "Desert Meal" charity dinner ticket sales \$648, and miscellaneous income \$401. There was a special donation received from the Columbus Club Association of Rochester Building Fund of \$10,000 (included on Schedule B). **Total Other Revenue:** Line 10 Grants and similar amounts paid out include the following: Total program service contributions donated to various organizations that assist mentally impaired individuals, scholarships for Catholic education, religious vocations support, annual Boysville quota and support, miscellaneous charities including Capuchin Soup Kitchen, homeless shelters, and supporting Parish and community service to South Oakland Shelter for homeless individuals and families to reenter the workforce. Organizations include Faith Works, Assistance League, Neighborhood House, Manna Community Meal, Forgotten Harvest, Baldwin Center, and Catholic Community Response Team.
