The organization is working on getting further approval from the Department of Education, State of Florida, to accept the two scholarships for children with special needs Once the organization has been assured we can accept these scholarships, it will be able to increase enrollment for the start of the school year in the fall of 2021. It is at this time that the organization will appoint employees.
