Minutes of Meeting of Board of Directors

The annual meeting of the Board of Directors of Acorn Projects and Partners, Ltd., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Pennsylvania with Certificate of Authority in Indiana, was held via email messages exchanged between June 20 and 22, 2020.

The action taken is as follows:

Motion was made by Michael Hart and modified by Ken Starkey: Resolved, to terminate operations and close the corporation no later than June 30, 2020. The remaining cash representing the only asset of the corporation shall be distributed to the following:

- Program funds to Florida Counseling Foundation, a public charity, for their work among underserved populations.
- Administrative funds to Michael Hart as a token of appreciation for 990 preparation services.

The resolution was unanimously approved via email response by each of the Directors of record:
