

Due to Covid-19, while all the recreation centers closed for the lock down Arlington Tennis Center is the only facility in the area opened in May. It has 28 courts which some could and did convert to Pickleball (PB) courts. Each court is fenced in by itself far away from the next court. This provides an ideal outdoor facility for people to come to play outdoors and at the same time observe social distancing. Since May 1st, they opened from Texas state lock down, GFT has assisted to provide PB equipment such as nets, paddles, balls as well as fees for teaching. Furthermore, GFT donated a tutoring machine (\$ 3,599 85) for the on site pro (teacher) to use for teaching purposes. Hundreds of players came each week. The city of Arlington lost nearly 30 million in revenue due to Covid-19, they could not fund any repairs or maintenance for Arlington Tennis Center. While the court grounds were cracking (after 4-5 years use) it needed resurface badly. It is an expensive job. GFT donated \$ 10,000.00 for this purpose. It is contracted and will finish the repair early 2021 weather permitting. In early December, ATC held a PB tournament, near 400 players attending and over 1000 visitors came to cheer and watch over 3 days period.
