and handicap modifications with an eye toward safe home environments. During COVID-19, our organization expanded programming to
include innovative ways to help our more isolated care receivers retain connection with the community at large through a series of
contactless "Porch Package" deliveries, Easter and Thanksgiving meal deliveries, and more. In 2020, our program volunteers provided 620
round trip rides to medical appointments, 292 grocery trips, 1,650 social connection opportunities, and our Honey Do Crews managed 87
home repairs/safety modifications. 100% of our services are provided FREE of charge to the care recipients.
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Part III, Line 28: Our Core Services programs focus on access to medical care, food, and supplies. We achieve this through volunteer
provided transportation. Often, the seniors we help are in such need that our program covers the costs of groceries and supplies or other
pasic needs on an individual case-by-case basis. We also coordinate the Senior Christmas Bureau, providing holiday joy to upwards of
100 are seniors each year. These funds were expended to make these efforts possible.
Part III, Line 29 : Our Honey Do Crews program performed 87 home repairs, maintenance projects, or handicap modifications to keep our
seniors safe in their home environment to ensure they can remain as independent as possible. These funds paid for materials and supplies.
