



Application Review

The Foundation will acknowledge each application received. All applications will go through an initial review. Some will be denied at this stage and some will move forward for further consideration. If an organization's application moves forward, it is likely that a site visit will be arranged. The site visit will be an opportunity for the Foundation to have a deeper conversation and get a more in-depth understanding of your request for a grant. It will require that the Executive Director, a Board member and possibly others from the organization be present at the site visit. Before the site visit, you will be

provided with questions that you may be asked by the Foundation. The purpose of the site visit is to have a very candid conversation. The Foundation wants to understand your organization, the leadership and the work you do in order that it can make the most informed and best funding decisions.

Final grant decisions will be announced approximately 10-12 weeks after each deadline. Not all applications move through the review process in the same manner or at the same rate. The Foundation cannot expedite a funding decision. Please do not contact the Foundation during the review period with questions regarding the status of your application.

All applicants will be informed of their grant request status, denied or awarded. All decisions are final.

Payments and Reporting
