In 2020 the organization did COVID response work to help ensure safe and clean elections during the pandemic. This work encompassed

1) Working with the NC legislature on the Bipartisan Election bill, HB 1169; 2) advocating for federal resources, and 3) advocacy communications around the 2020 elections to help folks vote in a safe manner.

The organization ran an online election information project. The organization worked to produce state/Federal State Board of Elections rules on voter intimidation alongside other nonprofit entities. The organization supported the Federal For the People Act. The organization created the NC For the People effort by doing a coalition listening tour to develop policy ideas. Then, the organization did research on best practices and policies to better our democracy which was published in a 2021 report. The organization supported the national efforts around the For the People Act. The organization advocated for judicial independence efforts. The organization also did work to protect the right to protest by developing policy ideas and post-election protest challenges scenario planning.
