Part 1 line 10 Paid out grant from Jessamine County CAIP agriculture development fund of \$171,014. Funds were applied for and administered through the Jess. Co. FFA alumni. Funds distributed through applications to area farmers. Unused funds returned to Ky State Treasury.

Paid out grant of \$5500.00 for 4H / FFA student agriculture projects. Money was received from the Governors office of agriculture policy.

Any funds not utilized by the students or administering the fund are paid back to the Kentucky State Treasury. 4H / FFA students can receive up to \$500.00 their 1st year of participation, \$250.00 2nd year applicants, and no funding 3rd year and beyond.

Part 1 line 16 These funds were spent supporting the Jessamine County Vocational Agriculture program (FFA). We sponsored local FFA annual Banquet, Help students attend National FFA convention. Give funds to help needy students buy FFA jacket or attend FFA Leadership camp. Jessamine alumni also helps with Thanksgiving food drive and greenhand initiation .

Part 1 line 20 Is accounts payable \$81,657. These funds will either be used to continue to pay on the grants stated Part 1 line 10 to farmers students or for administrating the fund. Any unused funds will be returned to the Kentucky State Treasury per the contract signed with the Governor's Office of Agriculture Policy. Unused funds will be due back early June 2021.

Part II line 26 These are accounts payable. They are to be paid out or returned to the Kentucky State Treasury by early June. See Part 1 line 20 above.
