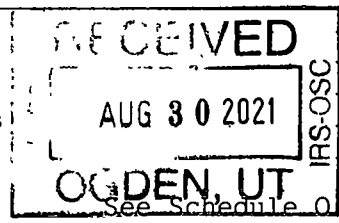

STATEMENT 1 - REASONABLE CAUSE FOR NOT FILING

THE TAXPAYER IS A 501(C)(4) ORGANIZATION. THE PURPOSE IS TO PROMOTE COMPETITIVE EQUINE SPORTS IN THE SQUAW VALLEY AREA (FOOTHILLS NEAR FRESNO, CA). THE ENTITY WAS FORMED 04/23/15. THE RETURNS WERE NOT FILED BECAUSE THE TAXPAYER RELIED ON THE TAX PROFESSIONAL AND THE ATTORNEY TO EXPLAIN THE FILING REQUIREMENTS AFTER ASSISTING WITH FORMATION. THIS DID NOT OCCUR. THE ENTITY CONTINUED TO KEEP ADEQUATE BOOKS AND RECORDS AND HELD ADMINISTRATIVE MEETINGS WITH ITS PARTICIPANTS DURING THE NON FILING PERIOD. THE TAXPAYER BELIEVED THEY WERE IN FULL COMPLIANCE. THE ENTITY WAS TERMINATED 05/15/19 (POSTED 08/12/19). THE ENTITY WAS PREPARING TO COME INTO COMPLIANCE FOR REINSTATEMENT BEFORE THEIR 15 MO PERIOD FOR STREAMLINED REINSTATEMENT. HOWEVER, THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC OCCURED AND FIRES IN THE FRESNO FOOTHILLS AND THE TAXPAYER COULD NOT FILE RETURNS AND REQUEST REINSTATEMENT UNTIL 06/15/21. THE TAXPAYER WANTS TO CONTINUE ITS COMMUNITY SERVICE AND WANTS TO COME INTO FULL COMPLIANCE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. ALL DELINQUENT RETURNS HAVE BEEN FILED AND FORM 1024-A HAS BEEN FILED TO REQUEST REINSTATEMENT. A PROFESSIONAL CPA FIRM HAS BEEN HIRED TO MONITOR COMPLIANCE. PLEASE ACCEPT THE ABOVE AS REASONABLE CAUSE.
