Grants and similar amounts paid: \$30,513 in total aid sent. \$27,914 in aid was sent to Divine Providence Home - \$6013 of which was a grant from the United Nations Women's Guild for new beds, cribs and mattresses and the remaining \$21,900 was wired directly from our account to assist with general expenses for the orphanage, including food, healthcare, tuition payments, Caretaker salaries and property repairs. \$2,600 in aid was sent to Colmcille Memorial Academy.

16. Other Expenses: \$1850 in total expenses. \$788 in event expenses for our 2020 Virtual Gala, \$507 in administrative expenses and \$195 in bank wire transfer fees.
