2. CEMIK is run by a local Maya Ixil women's organization. Mundo has supported this school for 14 years. Not only are we supporting the
education of 70 students ages 4-10 who otherwise would not be able to afford to go to school, we are also providing nutritional meals
to the students and their families. These students are learning about their rich Maya Ixil culture, heritage, and indigenous rights through
learning tools of literacy in both Ixil and Spanish, environmental care, and natural healing plants. Our donations also support the
employment of 4 Maya Ixil women who are literate in Spanish and English but do not hold the degrees necessary to teach in a public
school. Part of our focus this year has been to provide teacher inservices on literacy building tools for reading and mathematics.
3. The CEMIK/ACEFOMI Greenhouse was built and the women and students planted two crops of a variety of vegetables that were used
to support the nutrition of CEMIK families during COVID-19 lockdowns. The plan going forward is for teachers and students to learn
more about how to grow nutritive foods that can combat the ever present malnutrition in the Chajulense community.
4. Mundo supported the transportation and surgeries of 10 children with club feet at the Children of the Americas annual surgical week.
5. Mundo continues to support ASEPA, the adult literacy program in marginalized areas of the Capital Guatemala. ASEPA has been in
operation for over 20 years and provides literacy building skills to women and men between the ages of 16 and 85. It is a model program.
#29 - Mundo is supporting 9 scholars in their pursuit of education. 5 students are attending Basico (Jr and High School) and 4 are
studying at the universtiy level in the areas of teaching, law, forensics, and technology.
