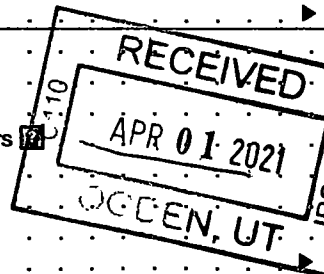

Seattle Contract Bridge League is a 501 c (7) corporation.

Our purpose is social and recreational.

We organize and conduct duplicate bridge tournaments in King county, Washington.

We are Unit #446 of a North American organization, The American Contract Bridge League (ACBL).

Our members pay a membership fee to our parent organization

The ACBL then forwards to our Unit a portion of those fees. We have reported on Line #1 the portion which we receive.

Our tournaments (normally about 6 per year) consist of duplicate bridge competition. Due to Covid 19, we held only one tournament in 2020.

While bridge is a card game, our tournaments are not "gaming events". No money is wagered.

The winners receive no cash, merchandise or anything of monetary value. Instead they are awarded and accumulate "master points".

These points establish skill levels for a local and national rating system.

We charge an entry fee for our tournaments.

We report the annual total of entry fees received as "Program Service Revenue" on Line #2.

We rent venues for our tournaments and rent space to park a trailer which holds card tables.

We report the total rentals and janitorial costs on Line #14.

We print and distribute flyers for our tournaments and publish a bi-monthly newsletter for our members.

We report the cost of flyers, publication and distribution on Line #15.

We incur a wide variety of other expenses primarily related to our tournaments. The largest of these are costs we incur for ACBL certified directors at our tournaments. Other large expenses are hospitality (refreshments) and hauling equipment and supplies to and from the tournaments. We have reported all of these expenses including smaller ones on Line #16.

We made one grant in 2020 for \$1000 to support young people in bridge. This is reported on Line #10
