As is evident, the Covid-19 pan demic continues to significantly limit the hospital's resources and abilities to address t he identified health concerns over the last year. However, several initiatives saw progres s or were completed during a significantly challenging time. Community Mental Health Taskf orce: The hospital participates in this taskforce created to address mental health issues in the county. They meet quarterly to develop resources and educational opportunities to b ring awareness and create dialogue between agencies to better care for mental health patie nts. Public educational forums are planned each spring and fall. Impact is monitored as ac tivities and initiatives continue to develop over the years. The goal is to educate the co mmunities in McPherson County about mental health issues and to develop inter-agency strat egies to provide appropriate care for patients. This taskforce took a break during the height of the pandemic. One of the challenges identified was using healthcare or law enforcem ent personnel to sit with at-risk

patients until appropriate levels of support could be se cured, which was pulling these resources away from other needs. As a result, we have contracted with a third party that provides one-on-one support for patients needing immediate m ental health observation, providing a safer environment for all parties, and allowing the medical teams and law enforcement to remain available for other needs. In addition, we have now implemented the Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale in our Emergency Department to help assess our patients' mental health status related to suicide so that appropriate in terventions can be administered if needed. All patients presenting to the Emergency Depart ment are now screened using this assessment tool. Assess Internal Employee Assistance Program and Provide Training: As a means of assisting hospital employees while educating them on mental health issues, the plan is to research available resources and opportunities for hospital employees to become educated about and engaged in management of their own potential issues as well as for patients.

Better educated employees will allow for appropriate tr eatment and care for themselves and their patients. This employee-focused assistance program is promoted during new employee orientation

Impact is monitored as activities and initiatives develop over the years. The goal is to educate the communities in McPherson County to help prevent abuse, make McPherson County a safer p lace and to get ahead of the epidemic. This group has met quarterly in the past but has su spended all meetings during the pandemic. It is unknown if meetings of the wider group will resume when we are not faced with pandemic challenges. We are aware that law enforcement continues to be involved in drug abuse education in our community.K-TRACS EHR Integration: This is a database designed to let physicians and pharmacists know if a patient is receiving and filling multiple controlled substance prescriptions. The plan is to integrate pat ient drug prescribing history into our EHR. Providers who are aware of their current and p ast prescriptions can make informed decisions on what they are prescribing. A contract has been signed with the software interface management group. We are now fully functional in using K-TRACS in the emergency department with all of our physicians. Non-Narcotic Order Se t: The goal is to design an order set for electronic use that does not contain narcotics, thereby patients will not be exposed to as many narcotics. Providers are becoming aware that narcotics are sometimes not the safest form of pain management. This initiative continues to be delayed due to shifting focus of resources related to COVID-19. Electronic Prescri bing of Narcotics: The plan is to make it mandatory for all providers to electronically pr escribe narcotics. Electronically prescribing medications provides better tracking and dru g management, increasing provider awareness of patients' narcotic use. The State of Kansas now requires this practice. We are now fully 100%

compliant with this requirement, and ar e able to utilize waivers for printed scripts if the computer system is down. Provide Staf f Training and Education on Drug Abuse: The plan includes education from PrairieView Menta | Health Center for staff on how to properly identify and care for patients with a

substan ce abuse problem. Staff will be able to better identify and care for drug abuse patients a nd provide better education and referral services upon discharge. PrairieView, a major men tal health provider in the area has conducted staff training onsite for providers in the p ast, but challenges related to the pandemic have put a strain on resources, including staf fing and reallocation of resources.
