Providing financial assistance: WSOL annually hosts the following fundraising events in sole support of WMA, d/b/a the WSO:
a) Annual "Encore Affairs". Two events were held in this tax reporting year; b) Annual "Own Your Own Orchestra" Fundraising Campaign;
c) Annual major Dinner/Concert Fundraiser. Due to Covid-19, the dinner was postponed until next year, but some income was received.
Annual fundraising projects and goals are presented to the WSO Resource and Development Committee for review and coordination.
