Mercy did rece ive funding from the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"). Mercy received CARES Act funding across various entities for the year ended June 30, 2021 and recognized a portion of this funding in other operating revenue. These funds helped to offs et revenue losses and additional expenses incurred due to the pandemic; however, these funds fell short of the system losses experienced since the start of the pandemic. The impact of COVID-19 was significant to our communities and coworkers as unemployment rates soared and Mercy acted quickly to provide continuous care to patients and the community. Mercy continues to monitor the impacts of the pandemic both to the health system and the communit ies served as we continue to provide assistance and maintain access to care within our communities.
