Actual write-offs after management has used reasonable collection efforts are charged against allowance for doubtful accounts. During FY 2021, the Hospital decreased its estimate of the allowance for doubtful accounts from \$3,281,467 to \$2,248,767. The decrease in the allowance reflected the normalization of accounts receivable as in FY 2019 a reallocation of accounts due to an EMR implementation occurred and the Self-Pay accounts receivable increased by 56%. During FY 2021 and FY 2020, write-offs were \$469,529 and \$953,194, respectively. The costing methodology used in determining the amounts reported above was a ratio of cost to charge.
