All clients are invited into a faith-based community committed to practicing hospitality, showing respect, and restoring hope. The Bowery Mission's Residential Programs reflect the organization's commitment to welcoming, collaborative, and goaloriented care. With the support of an interdisciplinary team, residential clients are equipped with the tools and resources they need to achieve personal goals for employment, housing, wellness, relationships, and spiritual growth. In fiscal year 2021, 266 adults participated in The Bowery Mission's Residential Programs, using housing, counseling, classes and other support to make progress toward their goals.

The Bowery Mission's programs for children, Mont Lawn Camp and City Camp, empower children from low-income neighborhoods to thrive and succeed through opportunities for leadership, skill building, and personal growth. In fiscal year 2021, children continued to grow through online and in-person enrichment classes, mentoring and tutoring, while families received care for practical needs. In total, 188 children and youth built new life-long skills through community-based enrichment classes, tutoring and
