Grants -

HFL will not fund: underwriting for an organization's annual appeals/solicitations, special events or general fundraising; organizations who discriminate in any way based on participation or membership in a specific religious faith, race, gender, citizenship status, sexual orientation, age or disability; faith-based organizations will be considered for grants so long as the grant proceeds are used for programs offered by such organization that are offered to individuals regardless of their religious affiliation, race, gender, citizenship status, sexual orientation, age or disability; endowments; or lobbying or the support of any political candidate, political party or political activity.
